- Explore the unique learning/thinking/processing differences associated with autism spectrum disorders.
- Review sensory, communication and social differences in relation to appropriate accommodations/modifications to increase the child's understanding and functional/ meaningful independence.
- Increase awareness of the educational implications for students on the spectrum.
