December 5, 2014: Lenses on Reading

Do you believe everyone at your school is on the same page about literacy development and struggling readers? Review the continuum of philosophy of research and reading development, and learn what practices you can expect depending on each philosophy. Learn collaborative strategies to help us all expand beyond our silos. Participants will be provided an article to read ahead of time in order to better appreciate how disparate educators' understandings and descriptions of Rtl are. Be prepared to understand how a different view of Rtl might result in different decisions about next steps for struggling readers.
