Visual Processing and the Struggling Reader: Assessment and Instruction for

Description:

This workshop will explain the visual aspects involved in the reading process and the symptoms of visual processing difficulties.

Unlike the areas of speech & language, occupational and physical therapy, visual processing evaluations and vision therapy are NOT school provided services. Still, visual processing plays a major role in the reading process. The intent of this workshop is to expand a reading teacher's own "assessment lens" and increase his/ her repertoire of instructional strategies when working with readers whose struggles may be due to visual processing issues. Participants will be given hands on techniques for testing and helping struggling readers--all of which are appropriate for classroom and intervention teachers.

Workshop Objectives/Goals:

- Recognize visually related problems in the classroom setting
- Acquire easy, informal ways to test for these problems
- Acquire strategies to help readers
- Develop techniques to improve various learning issues
