Description

Data is available that will assist school districts in early identification of students who need support. A Dropout Early Warning System (DEWS) score is available for all students in grades 6-9, each year in WISEdash for Districts. The data will help you identify students who are showing potential for low achievement, currently under achieving, and especially those students who are in danger of dropping out of school altogether. This workshop will provide the time and direction to access and interpret your students' DEWS scores. We will share a process by which to review this critical data and help you determine the necessary steps to increase student achievement as part of school improvement. **Additionally, your district may qualify for additional support services from CESA 6 based upon your data analysis.**
