Description:

A primary goal of prekindergarten and kindergarten is to help children see themselves as readers – whether they are reading conventionally or not. This session will focus on three critical areas of learning in prekindergarten: story awareness, language awareness, and print awareness. This session will also support teachers in building an understanding of the reading process and of how the literacy that children experience in prekindergarten and kindergarten contributes to their long-term development as readers.

Workshop Objectives

- Explore three critical areas of learning: story awareness, language awareness, and print awareness
- Understand the values of interactive read-aloud as an instructional approach.
- Analyze text characteristics to support book selection
- Incorporate teaching routines of interactive read-aloud
- Plan an interactive read-aloud session
- Using shared and independent reading to develop early reading behaviors.
