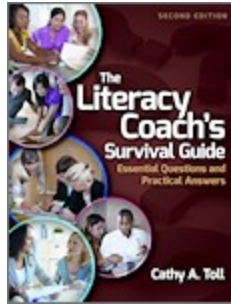

Strategies for Effective Educational Coaching



Goals:

- Participants will increase their understanding of effective coaching.
- Participants will develop strategies for effective coaching.

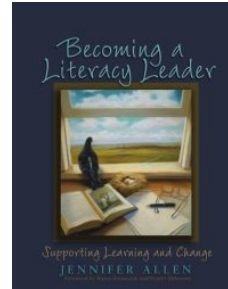
This workshop will provide an overview of formats, models and outcomes of effective educational coaching. Participants will then delve into the coaching conversation and learn processes for effectively helping teachers to understand challenges, develop goals and try something new, using data as a guide along the way. The special challenges of working with professional learning teams will be discussed, and strategies for success with teams will be shared. In addition, tools will be shared for working with difficult situations and finding time for coaching.



Workshop Description

Day 2: Jennifer Allen

Literacy Leadership



Exploring the Possibilities of Layered Coaching

Jennifer will share her framework for "layered coaching" as a model for coaches to develop their roles within schools. She will explore the role of the coach through the layers of being a resource, voluntary study groups, required staff professional development, coaching teachers in the classroom and supporting "students on the bubble."

Jennifer will emphasize the importance of making meaning together, while always keeping students at the center of conversations. Jennifer will also share her own pitfalls of learning and how her role has evolved and changed over the years to meet the shifting needs within her school.

Specific strategies will also be shared regarding how coaches can help teachers use assessment to inform instruction, refine curriculum and analyze student work. Jennifer's presentation will model how this work can be threaded within and across the coaching layers.
