Overview

Reach Out and Read prepares America's youngest children to succeed in school by partnering with clinicians to prescribe books and encourage families to read together. The program begins at the 6-month checkup and continues through age 5, with a special emphasis on children growing up in poverty. Age 0-5 are the most critical for brain and language development, and parents and caregivers play a crucial role in their child's development. Children who are read to at an early age develop a lifetime love of books and learning.

Cause for Concern

More than 30 percent of Wisconsin children enter kindergarten without the skills they need to learn to read. Studies show that 88 percent of these children never catch up. Children living in low-income families are particularly at risk. Learning to read impacts more than just a child's school performance. It impacts rates of youth school retention, juvenile delinquency and teen risk behaviors.

Who should attend:

- Pediatric Physicians, Family Care Physicians, Nurse Practitioners, Physician Assistants, Medical staff working with children age 0-5 and their families.
