Description:

This foundation workshop thoroughly explores the features and characteristics that comprise autism spectrum disorder (ASD). Numerous examples of "behaviors" in relation to the features and characteristics of ASD will be given. This foundation workshop is a priority for professionals and family members to develop an understanding of ASD from which to develop appropriate programming and intervention strategies.

Workshop objectives:

- Develop an understanding of the unique features and characteristics associated with autism spectrum disorder.
- Learn the DPI educational eligibility criteria for identifying a child with an autism spectrum disorder.
- Explore the unique learning/thinking/processing differences associated with autism spectrum disorder
- Review sensory, communication, cognitive and social differences in relation to appropriate accommodations/modifications to increase the child's understanding and functional/ meaningful independence.
- Increase awareness of the educational implications for students on the spectrum.
