Social Relation Skills and Strategies for Students with Autism Spectrum Disorder Kindergarten Through High School

Description:

This training will provide participants with an in-depth focus on the primary area of difficulty for people with autism spectrum disorder (ASD), social relation skills. Particular focus will be given to "social understanding", a significant feature of social development which is often absent or developmentally delayed in highly verbal students identified with ASD. Numerous tools and resources will be provided to address the various social thinking (learning) needs of people with ASD. **This training will give strategies specific to students with ASD who have high verbal skills and who may have previously been identified under high functioning autism or Asperger Syndrome.**

Workshop objectives:

- Define the various features and characteristics of social relation differences in verbal students with ASD.
- Identify the educational implications for social understanding differences for verbal students with ASD.
- Identify strategies and curriculums to enhance development of social relation skills for verbal students with ASD

Who should attend?
