Description:

The purpose of this session is to help teachers think about how writing and reading are closely connected processes. Teachers will also gain an understanding of how children's early attempts at writing help children learn about literacy and show teachers what they are noticing and learning.

Workshop Objectives

- Gain an understanding of how children's early attempts at writing help children learn about literacy.
- Understand how writing and reading are closely connected processes.
- Incorporate shared writing and interactive writing, along with independent writing and drawing, to provide children with opportunities to try things out as writers.
- Explore bookmaking as an important activity for young children, as well as how specific teacher language can support young writers as they expand their knowledge about writing during independent writing, shared writing, and interactive writing.
