Description of Workshop Modules

• Getting Ready: <u>Assessment & Grouping</u> Participants will learn how to utilize results from initial fall assessments to form groups for guided reading instruction. Participants will learn how to group students appropriately and how to create a small group rotation schedule, detailing the frequency suggested for meeting with each group.

• Teaching With Purpose: <u>Lesson Structure/Planning</u> Participants will take a close look at the structure of a guided reading lesson and will learn about: the introduction to the text, how to support readers during the reading of the text, and how to include a specific teaching point, following the discussion of the text. Demonstrations and video-taped lessons will be shown at various levels (A-N) to supplement the information provided.

Monitoring Progress: Deciding When to Move Levels

Participants will be guided in the process of using resources to monitor the progress of students throughout the school year. Participants will learn how to decide when to move students to new levels through the data collected from progress monitoring. A variety of resources will be shared that can be used to create progress monitoring resources. Guidelines will also be shared regarding the recommended frequency of progress monitoring.


• Keeping it All Together: Organization

Participants will learn about a variety of options for organizing materials for guided reading instruction. Tools and examples will be shared from teachers that are currently facilitating guided reading instruction in the classroom. Resources built from the Continuum of Literacy Learning will be provided to assist teachers with organization.
