WHAT A four-part series of events featuring a model-neutral curriculum that builds upon prior learning. The events will use a blended-learning approach, in which districts in all CESAs can learn together at the same event through virtual participation, but also collaborate and dive deeper into the work with their local districts. *There is no cost for participating.* Participants will:

- Receive clear and consistent statewide messaging regarding EE from DPI;
- Hear from nationally-renowned educational experts;
- Receive strategies to reduce local burden and increase distributive leadership capacity;
- Gain experience and strengthen skills in developing concrete school-level plans to implement EE for Continuous Improvement;
- Develop a new repertoire of instructional strategies;
- Learn from districts across the state;
- Take home clear, simple next steps and action plans to continue improving the work of EE, and instruction and learning in general; and
- Take home artifacts that can support each individual's EE process.
