Fountas & Pinnel Benchmark Assessment (BAS) Grades K-2, a two day series

Description

Through demonstration, guided practice, and discussion, participants in this two day workshop series will learn how to correctly administer, code, and score the Benchmark reading assessment to determine independent, instructional, and placement levels for readers using the Fountas and Pinnell A-Z Text Gradient. Participants will also summarize, analyze and interpret the results-including reading comprehension, fluency, accuracy, and word analysis, to assess the reader's current system of strategic actions and plan for instructional supports accordingly. Additionally, attendees will explore the multitude of additional BAS literacy assessments.

- * who will be using the F & P BAS as a tool for assessing and monitoring student progress in reading AND/OR who already are using the F & P BAS but are seeking to use assessment results to strategically plan student instruction

Session 2: Instructional Supports for Students and Additional BAS Assessments. In session two, participants will:

- Analyze and interpret results from their own student BAS protocols
- Plan instructional supports for their students using the Fountas and Pinnell Continuum of Literacy Learning
- Explore and Utilize the additional assessments offered by the BAS
