What is the Dropout Early Warning System (DEWS) and why is it important? This workshop will build an understanding of the DEWS score available in WISEdash for Districts (students in grades 6-9) and how it can be utilized for school improvement. You will learn how to access & identify students who are currently "at risk" or have potential for low achievement or dropout. This workshop will provide the time and direction to access and interpret DEWS scores for your students. A process will be shared to review this information and determine next steps.

Objectives:

- Learn more about the Wisconsin Dropout Early Warning System (DEWS) and its intended purpose
- Utilize a process for reviewing the DEWS data in your district/school
- Discuss possible interventions that may support identified students
- Network with others about how they have used this data for school improvement
