As the 2015-16 school year approaches, CESA 5 would like to make you aware of an opportunity to prepare for the implementation of Academic and Career Planning (ACP) requirements. We are excited to offer an opportunity to collaborate with your regional colleagues through a CESA 5 ACP Pilot.

# Purpose of the Pilot

Beginning in the 2017-18 school year, legislation requires every school board to provide ACP services to all pupils enrolled in grades 6 to 12. To prepare for the statewide implementation of ACP, CESA 5 is offering partnering districts ACP process training and implementation support. This project is intended to mirror DPI's ACP pilot, while giving districts flexibility in their level of commitment.

#### Objectives

- 1. Assess the level of district needs and supportive services,
- 2. Test/revise initial versions of professional development and guidance resources.
- 3. Gather best practices and strategies, and
- 4. Develop a network of lead school districts throughout the region.
