Woodcock-Johnson IV Tests of Achievement

Description:

This workshop teaches administration, scoring, and interpretation of all the tests of achievement, with emphasis on the new tests and the changes from the WJ III. All administration and scoring details will be reviewed, followed by modeling of the procedures on video, and an opportunity for participants to practice scoring. There will also be an emphasis on interpretation of the test results. Additionally, tests from the WJ IV Oral Language battery will be reviewed, with emphasis on the tests most applicable to a learning disability assessment.

About the presenter:

Milton J. Dehn, PhD, NCSP, is a nationally recognized expert on psychoeducational assessment and children's memory problems. A former school psychology professor, Dr. Dehn is now a private practice school psychologist and the program director for Schoolhouse Educational Services. He has authored books on cognitive and memory assessment, and is the author of a psychological test and test-scoring software.
