Four Integral Sessions for Enhancing Your Systems

Strong schools don't just happen-they build on the strengths of staff, students, family and community. It takes careful attention to foundational practices to ensure your culturally responsive multi-level system is running smoothly, so all students will learn. The South Region created four sessions in response to your requests and data.



Session 1: Take Back Your Time With an Efficient and Effective System-November 2, 2015

Wouldn't it be great to feel like you had more hours in the day? This session will help you capture more time by streamlining your system. Participants will examine current structures, teams, and responsibilities with a culturally responsive lens. Teams will leave with an action plan that promotes an efficient and effective system.



Session 2: How to Integrate Data and Use it Well - December 15, 2015 9

Essential to a well-established system, is making decisions based on data. In this session, participants will work in teams to explore their implementation and student level data at both the aggregate and disaggregate levels. Teams will leave with strategies and resources to support ongoing data-based decision making.



Session 3: Family Engagement: Making a Difference - February 18, 2016

All families want their children to succeed. School teams, who intentionally and purposefully seek out and include the identity and voice of all families, build relationships, increase engagement, and improve academic success for all students. This session will help you refine or create an action plan to increase family engagement, including strategies to involve families in school-wide decision making and promote two-way communication.



Session 4: Year-End Assessments for Future Planning - May 23, 2016

The best way to plan for the future is to look back at the past. Assessments can be a useful way to gauge the effectiveness of your past and present implementation, as well as plan for future effectiveness. This session will help you understand the purpose of different assessment tools, analyze your current data, and start action planning for the future.
