The Need for Instructional Coaches

According to University of Kansas researcher Jim Knight, the chances of a teacher implementing a new instructional skill in the classroom after a single workshop is about 10%. Add modeling, practice and feedback to that training, and the percentage of implementation only increases to 16-19%. But add *coaching* to the training, and implementation increases to 95%! **It's clear that instructional coaching increases the likelihood of teacher effectiveness, which in turn increases student success.**

In the last two years, over 100 educational professionals have gone through the instructional coaching training offered through CESA 8. Our hope is that a vast majority of those trained professionals are doing some type of coaching back in their districts, and we'd like to support their work. To that end, we are forming an Instructional Coaches Network for the CESA 8 area.
