

# **Registration Process**

To register online for graduate credit from Saint Mary's University, follow these easy steps.

- 1. Go to <u>pdi.smumn.edu</u>
- 2. Select "Learner Login" in top toolbar
- Enter username ( cesa10 ) and password ( cesa10 )
- Select the blue REGISTER button for the course and section number for which you want to register
