#### **Description:**

Discover how you can use ongoing coaching to increase capacity in your schools. This session is built upon research-based strategies that have been proven to positively impact instruction. School based coaches responsible for supporting adult learners to improve instructional outcomes will develop and refine knowledge and skills related to building trusting relationships, guiding professional learning, and engaging

individuals and/or teams in authentic collaboration.

#### Workshop objectives:

- Develop an understanding of the use of coaching as an effective form of professional development in the school setting.
- Develop an understanding of the roles and responsibilities of coaches and administrators, in implementing a successful coaching program for professional development.
- Develop an understanding of how "growth mindset" and "systems change" leadership can transform teacher and student learning.
- Understand how change impacts adult learners, and learn strategies to support learners through the change process.
- Develop an understanding of "coach centric" leadership, and increase his/her coaching tool box to help build capacity in individual and/or teams of teachers.
- Explore ways to use data and promote self reflection for decision making for professional goal setting, instructional implementation, and progress monitoring.
- Explore guidelines and resources to develop a coaching framework at the building level.

#### Who should attend?

An individual or teams of professional educators responsible for providing instructional support to teachers in school based settings. Coaches and administrators will benefit from this collaborative training opportunity.
