CESA 2 is offering a book study facilitated by Karen Russell, Early Childhood Program Support Teacher and Mary Jo Ziegler, Title 1 Network Coordinator. The focus is on Literacy Skills and Strategies that support these developmental skills within your classroom and work with preschoolers. Discussion will center on your current practices, building in additional supports and planning for next steps. Site visits to support implementation can be included. Livebinder will be used to organize and share resources.

The book study will be in two groups...come to the first two sessions and receive one graduate credit from Concordia University. You will be reading Engaging Young Writers by Matt Glover.

If you are taking it for 2 credits we will also use strategies from Talking, Drawing, Writing: Lessons for Our Youngest Learners and Write Out of the Box resources.

The cost for each graduate credit is \$141.25. If taking for two credits the total would be \$282.50. Credits will be available from Concordia University. Registry credit and CEUs are also available.
