## Description

Where other assessment and benchmark systems leave you wondering "Now what?" Fountas and Pinnell provide a link from assessment to instruction via classroom practices such as guided reading and read-aloud. Their professional book, *The Continuum of Literacy Learning: A Guide to Teaching*, is included with the Fountas & Pinnell Benchmark Assessment System and provides the basis for this workshop.

Drawing from this important resource, the workshop provides how The Continuum can be used to set goals for learning in planning lessons for individuals, small groups, and the whole class. You will create a reading and writing unit of study. A basis for the three workshop model will be discussed, and how to use The Continuum to create them.

- Apply a bank of learner outcomes for daily mini-lessons and conferring sessions in Reading and Writing Workshop.
- Create individualized word work / word study per guided reading level.
