PRESS is a systematic framework that uses collaborative decision-making using protocols designed to strengthen core instruction, facilitate analysis of literacy data, plan supplemental tier 1 supports for whole-class implementation, as well as small group interventions.

This workshop will include:

- Class-wide Interventions
- Tier 2 Interventions
- Introduction to Progress Monitoring

Participants will learn an efficient process for data teams to analyze screening data and plan supplemental tier 1 supports for whole-class implementation. Additionally, participants will learn how to identify students' intervention needs using the PRESS diagnostic tools and select and implement skill-based interventions from PRESS Intervention Manual.
