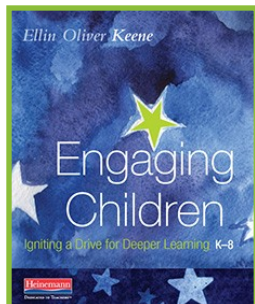


## ELLIN OLIVER KEENE— ENGAGING CHILDREN: IGNITING A DRIVE FOR DEEPER LEARNING

develop and recognize true student engagement in your classroom and help students take more responsibility for their learning.

She served as Deputy Director and Director of Literacy and Staff Development for the Cornerstone Project at the University of Pennsylvania for four years. Currently, Ellin works with schools and districts throughout the country and abroad with an emphasis on long-term, school-based professional development and strategic planning for literacy learning. Ellin is the author of six books on reading comprehension, discourse in the classroom, and, most recently on helping students learn to become deeply engaged and independent in their learning.
