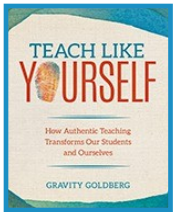


TEACH LIKE YOURSELF: HOW AUTHENTIC TEACHING TRANSFORMS OUR STUDENTS AND OURSELVES

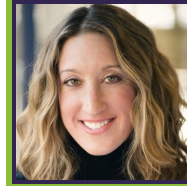
