Description

In addition, participants will look at the Benchmarks of Quality to begin to understand the use of the tool in self-evaluation.
- Understand the essential components of school-wide positive support systems that
 provide behavior supports to all students. Plan implementation through development of
 systems, data and practice. Plan for stakeholder buy-in, implementation and sustainability.
 Receive technical assistance from PBIS network in developing and planning for
 implementation at of school-wide systems.
