Description:

This interactive workshop will increase participant understanding of the CCR-IEP Process through the lens of related services. The focus will be on the application of Steps 1, 2 and 3.

- Participants will build their capacity to apply Step 1 (Understand Achievement), Step 2 (Identify Effects of Disability and Disability Related Needs, and Step 3 (Develop Ambitious and Achievable Goals) so they can develop IEPs designed to improve access, engagement, and progress for students with IEPs
- Participants will increase their awareness of CCR-IEP resources available to support the development of CCR-IEPs

Teams of at least 2: Administrators, Related Service Providers, Special Education Teachers, General Education Teachers, and Pupil Services

What should you bring?
