



SUMMER CRASH COURSE! CONFERRING WITH READERS & WRITERS in GRADES K—8

JUNE 17—18, 2020 | 9 AM – 3 PM

Join us for one or both days of this crash course on conferring with readers and/or writers in a workshop format. Conferring is an art which focuses on teaching the writer (*not the writing*) and the reader (*not the book*). Conferring is one of the most challenging parts of Reading and Writing Workshop. This two-day series will support teachers in the structure, management, content, and accountability of conferring. Day 1 will focus on conferring with readers and will emphasize the work of Jennifer Serravallo (*specifically her new book, [Reading Conferences](#)*). Day 2 will focus on conferring with writers and will emphasize the work of Carl Anderson (*specifically his new book, [Writing Conferences](#)*). Participants will study the structure of a conference and different methods of conferring. Every one will walk away from either day with practical tools to begin conferring from the first day of school.
