When a student struggles academically we use data to inform our instruction. We determine why a student is making an “academic error” and create an intervention that will allow us to reteach with mastery as our goal. The same approach can be used to address a student’s “social learning error(s).”

These sessions will explore a proactive, systematic solution seeking framework to address behaviors of concern by looking at the function - the “why” - of the behavior and then applying an intervention(s) that will provide supports and promote positive learning environments, all with mastery as our goal.
