The Red, Gold, Purple, and Teal Systems are designed for the lowest achieving students in **grades 3 - 12**, who are in need of a comprehensive, intensive literacy intervention. Lessons utilize engaging texts and are systematically designed to address comprehension, fluency, word study and writing about reading. The goal of LLI is to accelerate reading development and bring students to grade level.

Teachers (Classroom, Title I, Special Education, ELL) of struggling readers in grades 3—12, Literacy Coaches, Reading Specialists, and Interventionists.
