Through this training you will learn the foundations of S.M.A.R.T., including the research behind it, the basic movements of a S.M.A.R.T. course, how to implement it within your current curriculum, and how to modify/expand S.M.A.R.T. according to group and student needs. You will also prepare materials and lesson plans to be able to begin S.M.A.R.T. in your classroom right away.
