Description S300/S301

- **Day 3 and Day 4** will provide an introduction to the concepts and systems of functional assessment and behavior intervention planning to support individual students' behavior. This session will focus on simple functional assessment tools, brief intervention planning, and progress-monitoring of plans. **Prerequisite:** S100/S200

Objectives:

- Write one behavioral pathway (setting events, antecedents, behavior, consequences)
- Create one effective Behavioral Intervention Plan (BIP)
- Learn how to use data for decision making and on-going progress monitoring
- Develop a system for how and when FBA/BIP's will be conducted
- Action Plan: Develop a function-based behavioral intervention plan for an individual student using the competing behavior pathway

Audience

- Building Level Secondary Systems Planning Team (building administrator, internal coach, special and general education teachers, school counselors, social worker and/or psychologist, support staff, family and community members, Secondary/Tertiary District Coach)

What to bring

- Tier 2 Secondary/Tier 2 Tertiary Tracking Tool (completed for simple Tier 2 Secondary level)
- Tier 1 Universal & Tier 2 Secondary data for one to three students who seem to need more than simple Tier 2 Secondary interventions (behavior data: OSS, ISS, time-outs, attendance, Daily Progress Report data, SWIS graphs: time of day, location, type of behavior, consequence; academic data, grades, DIBELS, etc)
- Current district/building FBA/BIP forms/tools including those from current Tier 2 Secondary team/s (observation forms, teacher referral forms, etc)
- Plans/policies for simple Tier 2 Secondary level supports (Tier 2/Tier 3 Guidance Tool where completed, SAT, Targeted Teams, etc)
- Recommended resource: ***Building Positive Behavior Support Systems in Schools-Functional Behavioral Assessment*** by Crone, Horner

Bundled cost

- \$2200.00 for a team of six or less for 5 day, \$400 each for additional team member(s) over six.
