# Power with the Prompting Guide

## Leveled Literacy Intervention for Grades K-2

### Description:

LLI is a small group intervention for children in Kindergarten and Grades 1 and 2, who find reading and writing difficult to learn. Reading Recovery® is recommended for the lowest first grade students, and other low students may be serviced through Leveled Literacy Intervention® in groups of three. In Kindergarten and Grade 2, the children selected for the interventions are the lowest achievers in literacy in their grade level and are not receiving another intervention.

### Workshop Objectives:

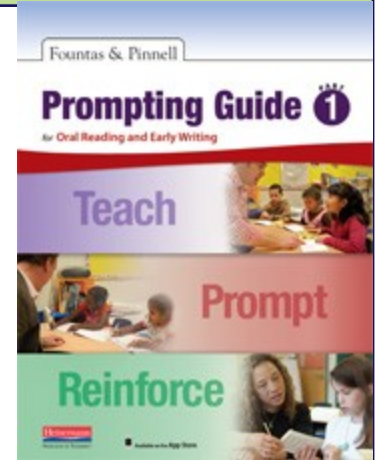
- Utilize the Prompting Guide to assist in establishing young readers early reading behaviors
- Create language to use when assisting readers with word solving strategies
- Incorporate prompting language when students are beginning the early writing stages
- Understand how to use the prompting guide with any small group instruction: LLI and Guided Reading
- Creating prompting language to use with students after analysis of running records to promote reading independence

### Leveled Literacy Intervention Features:

- Fast-paced lessons that include explicit instruction in phonemics/phonics, vocabulary, fluency, and comprehension
- Daily lesson guides with prescribed sequences of texts
- Instructional interactions between teachers and students with a 3:1 student-teacher ratio
- Emphasis on comprehension of fiction and non fiction texts with time engaged in reading continuous texts
- Continuum of student understandings to guide the series of lessons

**Who should attend:** For first year LLI teachers of Grades K-2 whose students are struggling with reading and writing, previously trained LLI teachers, reading teachers and Tier 1 Classroom teachers who teach guided reading.

**Cancellation Policy:** Any registration cancellation must be received 48 hours before the scheduled date for a refund to be issued. Because attendance at most sessions is limited, persons registering and not in attendance on the day of the session will be charged the full registration fee.
