Description:

LLI is a small group intervention for children in Kindergarten and Grades 1 and 2, who find reading and writing difficult to learn. Reading Recovery® is recommended for the lowest first grade students, and other low students may be serviced through Leveled Literacy Intervention® in groups of three. In Kindergarten and Grade 2, the children selected for the interventions are the lowest achievers in literacy in their grade level and are not receiving another intervention.

Workshop Objectives:

- Gain an understanding of how reads process texts
- Understand the twelve systems of strategic actions as an integrated, complex, cognitive network in which readers engage flexibly and simultaneously as they process text.
- Understand the systems of strategic actions for processing text through the lens of genre understanding.
- Understand how to analyze the potential demands of texts on readers by looking at the ten factors related to text complexity.

Leveled Literacy Intervention Features:

- Fast-paced lessons that include explicit instruction in phonemics/phonics, vocabulary, fluency, and comprehension
- Daily lesson guides with prescribed sequences of texts
- Instructional interactions between teachers and students with a 3:1 student-teacher ratio
- Emphasis on comprehension of fiction and non fiction texts with time engaged in reading continuous texts
- Continuum of student understandings to guide the series of lessons
