About LLI:

Leveled Literacy Intervention Red and Gold systems are specifically written and designed to address the interests and needs of students in grades 3 and 4 who are falling below grade-level expectations in reading. Lessons provide students with opportunities to read a variety of genres while working on comprehension, vocabulary, fluency, and writing about reading.

Leveled Literacy Intervention Features:

LLI 3-6 Workshop Offerings for 2014-2015

LLI Workshop Offerings:

For the 2014-2015 school year, teachers are able to pick and choose, mix and match which LLI sessions they want to attend. The cost is \$150 per teacher per session for the first 3 baseline workshops. Each add-on workshop cost is \$125.

Examples

- Send 1 teacher to 3 days of training for \$450. Each add-on workshop is priced at \$125 per day.
- Or send 3 teachers to one day of training for \$450; each add-on workshop is priced at \$125 per day per teacher.
- Or send 3 teachers to different days of training; the first 3 days cost \$450, each Add-on day is priced at \$125 per day per teacher.

Before joining the CESA 6 literacy team she worked as a Reading Specialist and Reading Coach, K-12 and as a Title I teacher at the elementary and middle school levels. Anne also taught early childhood special education and Kindergarten. Anne has extensive background knowledge of Fountas and Pinnell's Literacy Continuum and the LLI intervention program.
