Description:

Leveled Literacy Intervention Red, Gold and Purple systems are specifically written and designed to address the interests and needs of students in grades 3, 4 and 5 who are falling below grade level expectations in reading. Lessons provide students with opportunities to read a variety of genres while working on comprehension, vocabulary, fluency, and writing about reading.



Workshop Objectives:

- Gain an understanding of how reads process texts
- Understand the twelve systems of strategic actions as an integrated, complex, cognitive network in which readers engage flexibly and simultaneously as they process text
- Understand the systems of strategic actions for processing text through the lens of genre understanding
- Understand how to analyze he potential demands of texts on readers by looking at the ten factors related to text complexity

Leveled Literacy Intervention Features:

- Fast-paced lessons that include explicit instruction in word study/vocabulary, fluency, comprehension and reading about writing
- Daily lesson guides with prescribed sequences of texts, Novel Studies and Test Preparation lessons
- Instructional interactions between teachers and students with a 4:1 student teacher ratio
- Emphasis on deeper comprehension of fiction and non fiction texts with a focus on genre
- Continuum of student understandings to guide the series of lessons
