Description: Guided Reading Plus Groups are for children in grades one through 4+ who are reading at the early to transitional levels of reading and writing, but are lagging behind their classmates. The lesson includes several components including a building background phase which is a newly added component to the intervention designed specifically to build background knowledge, vocabulary density and language skills. Other lesson components include word study, guided reading, and a writing component. This small group intervention employs predictable structures using evidence based practices within a 30 minute time frame as a supplemental intervention conducted 4-5 days per week depending on intensity needs. Group size also varies based on intensity needs.

Workshop Objectives

- Transform struggling students into successful readers and writers;
- Align small group intervention with classroom instruction;
- Build small-group interventions based on the Comprehension Intervention Model.

Who should attend: Grades 1-5: Title I teachers, Special Education teachers, ESL teachers, and CIM Specialists in training.
