Description

Reading and writing are language processes that use many of the same strategies to communicate meaning. Writing is a powerful intervention for increasing reading achievement, but only if reading and writing are taught as reciprocal processes. The Interactive Writing Intervention is a 30 minute supplemental intervention for K and 1 students at the early to emergent levels that provides a language context for enabling students to:

- compose simple messages .
- acquire foundational concepts about print .
- . understand that writing is about communicating a message
- apply rereading strategies to predict and monitor the reading
- articulate words slowly and hear and record letters in words
- . use simple resources as self-help tools (ABC chart, personal dictionary, writing checklist)
- write letters fluently and with correct formation
- build a core of high-frequency words
- build vocabulary
- compare and contrast texts, characters, setting
- analyze characters •

Workshop Objectives:

Participants will learn about phase 1 and phase 2 of this intervention including the new preparing for the phases component which builds background by attending to the speaking, listening and language standards of the CCSS. Participants will learn about entrance, exit and progress monitoring criteria.
