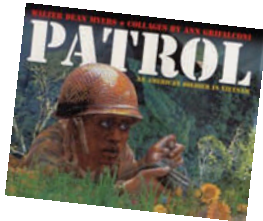

Make better writing and collaborative assessment a part of every day across the curriculum.



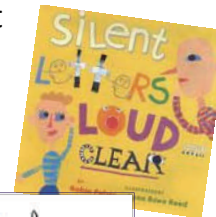

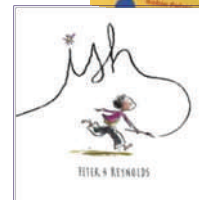

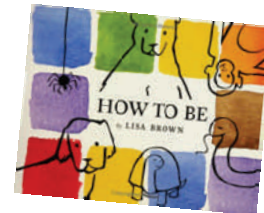
