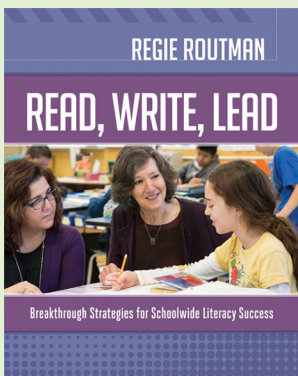
- Instructional practices that lead to better engagement and achievement in reading and writing.
