

Registration Process

Thank you for requesting graduate credit from Saint Mary's University.

To register online for graduate credit from Saint Mary's University, follow these easy steps.

1. Go to pdi.smumn.edu
2. Click on "Learner Login" in top toolbar
3. Enter district username (**cesa10**) and password (**cesa10**)
4. Click on the blue REGISTER button for the course and section number for which you want to register
