About the Presenter:

Dr. Timothy J. McNamara is a private K-12 mathematics consultant and professional developer contributing to improvement efforts for schools nationwide. He also serves as a Mathematics Specialist at and for the New York State Education Department in Albany. Tim was a classroom math instructor in the Western New York State region from 1975 to 2004. Two of the high schools he taught at- Williamsville East H.S. near his hometown of Buffalo and Irondequoit H.S. near Rochester- were both recognized as "Top 100 High Schools in America" in separate articles by *Newsweek* magazine. He also served five years as the West Irondequoit district's K-12 math curriculum supervisor and four years as an assistant professor of mathematics at the Damon City (Rochester) Campus of Monroe Community College.



This workshop will highlight workable strategies for teachers to meet the challenges that differentiated instruction presents, even though it has been shown to help all students learn. Acknowledging the work of Dr. Marian Small and others in the field, the pedagogical lens will focus upon not only how to improve the art of questioning but also how to enrich the quality of assessment problems themselves, both of which will encourage more higher-order thinking across a wider range of student abilities.

All material will be presented in a unique and thought-provoking manner and organized around the five mathematic goals as reflected in the NCTM's Content Strands.
