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Objectives

Participant will revisit essential school-wide systems (data, teaching, acknowledgement, and interventions) and use the Team Implementation Checklist to self-assess current implementation and action plan around identified needs. In addition, participants will look at the Benchmarks of Quality to begin to understand the use of the tool in self-evaluation. Lastly, teams will review effective and efficient classroom management systems and draft strategy to link classroom systems to their school-wide PBIS framework.

Completion of this day is a necessary part of Tier 2 readiness.

Target Audience

Building level Universal team that includes: Building administrator, external and internal coaches, regular education teachers that represent grade levels, special education teacher, social worker and/or psychologist, specials teacher, paraprofessional and family members.
