The IEP is the most critical document and communication tool in special education. This training will focus on “tricks of the trade,” balancing compliance with best practice. The focus will be on the “science” of IEPs, including the development of a compliant, measurable working document that communicates the unique needs of students with disabilities. Topics will include the development of measurable present levels of performance, annual goals, and objectives/benchmarks, along with other IEP components. An IEP Checklist and Rubric will be provided as a guide for development and quality review. In addition, Indicator 13 and transition planning will be included in the training, primarily on the use of the Postsecondary Transition Plan (PTP) and development of the I-8 in a technically sound manner.
