



Interested in purchasing a 3D printer? Would you like to try it out first?

CESA 2 has a MakerBot Replicator 2 available for check-out!

Details on check-out:

- It can be checked-out for 2 week blocks of time (or up to 3.14 weeks when no waiting list).
- You will have to attend a training before checking it out (see below).
- We will have an official policy and signature form (requiring teacher and administrative sign-off) stating that if you or your students break it, you will have to pay for repairs.
- The cost will be \$50 for two weeks, which will include use of two half or one whole spool of plastic.
- There's an expectation, of course, that you will take good care of it. ☺ That would include basic cleaning and maintenance, otherwise a \$50 cleaning fee may apply (basically, Kevin does not want to have to unclog the nozzles after each time it's loaned out).
- It can be delivered by the CESA 2 van if your district has that service. Or, it can be picked up and dropped off in Whitewater or Middleton.

Required Training:

- Before teachers can check out the 3D printer, they have to attend a training on using and servicing it.
- First training will be Nov 3rd, 2014 from 4pm to 6pm at Sector67 in Madison. The training will cost \$25, though STEM Network districts are free.
