What: Training is required for those who will administer Dynamic Learning Maps alternate assessments in 2014-15. Test administrators must successfully complete seven modules with a passing score on each module's post-test quiz before testing begins.

This facilitated training will go through the test administration training modules on the DLM website with opportunity for questions and discussion. The goal is to have all attendees pass the required assessments to be able to administer the spring DLM assessment.

Who: Staff who will be administering the DLM assessment

Other:

- ♦ Bring a laptop to access and take quizzes
- ♦ Before the training all users must have logged into KITE at least once
 - Talk with District Assessment Coordinator or Student Services Director to ensure access rights have been granted
 - Know who their district has assigned the following roles:
 - * District Assessment Coordinator
 - * Data Steward
 - * Technical Liaison
- ♦ Field testing before the spring test window is strongly recommended. There is still time to participate in Phase C field test January 5-March 6. Field test information can be found at <http://dynamiclearningmaps.org/content/ft2014-15>
