OSHA 10-Hour General Industry Registration Form

CESA 10 is pleased to offer OSHA 10-hour general industry training. This training teaches safety awareness and helps each worker recognize and reduce the risks of jobsite hazards. This OSHA hazard recognition course covers general industry hazards and is intended as an orientation to OSHA standards. OSHA recommends workplace safety training for a safe and healthful work environment.

NOTE: The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services requires public employees to comply with OSHA requirements adopted under s. SPS 332.50.

Registration Cost

Cost for this training is \$375 per person. However, if your district currently has an Environmental Health and Safety contract with CESA 10, attendees will receive a \$100 discount for a total cost of \$275 per person.
