3 Credit Option Online Graduate Class

Increasingly, online education is becoming an important option for K-12 education. The future of education will encompass online learning at all grade levels---blended, flipped and fully online.

Brief Description

The three phases of this online course explore:

- 1. Overview of online teaching
- 2. Current online teaching techniques
- 3. Putting it all together for effective application

Participants will explore online tools, resources, and videos. Topics addressed will include online learning, blended learning, virtual schools, rolling enrollment and flipped classroom techniques. Participants will create a roadmap for future use in creating an effective online course. Course activities address the needs and interests of K-12 educators.
