The CCSS have been adopted by 48 states and are now the basis of our new state assessment, Smarter Balanced Assessment, which will begin being utilized during the 2014-2015 school year. The demands are greater and more significant than in the past. We need to identify the changes that need to be made at our foundational levels to best support our learners. This will be an intense two days of work with additional work expected from participants within their districts.
