Participants will take away knowledge of each tool and how to use it.

The **DP-3** is a parent interview format norm-referenced tool that can reliably evaluate a child's overall development as part of special education eligibility.

The **DAYC-2** is an individually administered, norm-referenced measure of early childhood development.

Again, it can reliably evaluate for special education eligibility.

The **DECA-P2** is a behavior rating scale that is completed by parents and teachers and provides an assessment of within-child protective factors related to resilience as well as a screener for behavior concerns in children ages 3 through 5.
